

Habitat:

3. Places for Living

Every living thing, plant or animal needs at least 4 things from the environment.

1. Food or nutrient, something to eat or to feed its roots.
2. Space or habitat; somewhere to grow or feed.
3. Water to allow bio-chemical processes to operate.
4. Mates; other plants or animals of the same kind (species) for reproduction.

Can you pick two plants and two animals and show how they solve these problems?
 Information: Plants need pollen from another plant of the same species to make seeds.

Subject	Food	Habitat	Water	Mates
Example: Striped Legless Lizard	Catches insects around and under rocks.	Needs rocks and logs for insects to grow.	Gets most from its food. Needs cool, moist places to escape from fire.	If grass tussocks and rocks are gone, it's hard to find a mate for reproduction.
